



Grand Paris - Greater London Dialogues

Meetings have taken place over the past 6 months in Paris and London to explore the opportunity to create a new dialogue between urban development and real estate investment parties across our great metros. The initiative comes from a close collaboration between the Paris based Cercle Grand Paris de l'Investissement Durable (Grand Paris Alliance) and London based World Cities Network.

Strong interest has been identified from the City of Paris, the Regional Agencies of Paris, the Greater London Authority, members of the London Assembly and a number of leaders from private sector developers and investors in both cities.



There is a belief that there is value in a sustained and focused dialogue to understand our respective approaches to city development and to explore investment opportunities. Our metros have much to learn from each other and much to gain from a strategic level of engagement.

There is of course already significant cross channel business and strong connections. However our experience over the past four years working in these areas is that there remains misunderstanding, misconceptions, and perhaps an over simplistic understanding of our city regions that holds back an even more fruitful relationship.

During MIPIM we will be gathering leaders from London and Paris to discuss what kind of dialogue and programme would be most useful in 2015. **The discussion will take place on Friday 13th March at 10am.** Location in Cannes to be confirmed.
