Concept note. A prosperous future of cities with people's participation is the best way to implement the NUA. International Real Estate Federation (FIABCI) at World Panama Congress in May 2016 decided to support local and national authorities in reaching SDGs and therefore presented at Habitat III an online tool, based on the people's perception, to monitor the urban progress in reaching SDGs. UN-Habitat was recognized by Habitat III as "*a focal point to implement the New Urban Agenda*". FIABCI, on the basis of a MoU with UN-Habitat signed in May 17 in Nairobi, changed the methodology of its online tool according UN-Habitat indications to complement with a qualitative analysis based on perception, a quantitative UN-Habitat analysis based on data, City Prosperity Initiative. Millions of people will need in next years for the population growth and urbanization trend affordable houses. The private RE sector wants to cooperate with authorities in meeting these needs and the perception tool (CPI-PI), on line at http://citysvil.mesys.it, will facilitate to have them in affordable, prosperous cities. The World is changing rapidly and new technologies, as block-chain, should maybe be considered as instruments to contribute to have a world, and not only a market, more transparent in the interest of the community.
